## Science

'Egg Drop Challenge: You are responsible for building a device that an egg will rest in so it doesn't crack when dropped from a height of 6 feet (2 metres). You can involve your family in this project if they have time. Let's get started on keeping your egg safe!

1. *Design your egg protection device. Brainstorm ideas, make drawings, gather supplies.  
You can use items such as newspaper, tissue paper, bubble wrap, cardboard, straws, Sellotape etc. Note: You CAN NOT build a "landing pad" to soften the drop.*
2. *Pick a design and build a prototype of your egg protection device. Think about how you might slow the rate of descent, provide cushion, defy gravity etc.*
3. *Test your design by dropping your egg from 6 feet. Is your egg crack free after landing?*
4. *Take a video or a picture of your prototype and the results of your test. How did your prototype work? Is your egg crack free? What was the biggest challenge? What would you redesign?*
5. *Add the picture of your design/video of the 'drop' to Seesaw.*
